The images above are the only approved identifiers for ALL uses when representing the fraternity. All other and former identifiers are prohibited from use. The use of any other identifiers require written approval from the international headquarters.

Mascots & Intellectual Property

Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., does not have a mascot. The fraternity's approved imagery and identifiers are to be used in reference to the fraternity and its regions, chapters, and members. The use of individual elements of the shield, seal, badge, etc., as representations of the fraternity, is prohibited.

The use of mascots such as camels, wolves, blue devils, cartoon characters, and the intellectual property (trademarks, copyrights, and patents) of other entities are strictly forbidden.

Chapter Nicknames + Monikers

The fraternity prohibits the use of custom chapter logos as identifiers for the organization. To maintain a consistent brand and image the approved fraternity identifiers are to be used at all times. Exceptions to the chapter logo guideline include custom identifiers for milestones or special observances such as chapter anniversaries.

Items such as t-shirts, lapel pins, apparel, etc., for milestones, are allowed as long as they comply with the fraternities vendor guidelines.

The unauthorized use of intellectual property (trademarks, copyright) is strictly prohibited.

Vendor Licensing

All business entities selling goods bearing Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., Insignia, trademarks, etc., must be members of the vendor licensing program through Affinity Licensing (www.greeklicensing.com).
